

ORDINANCE TO REGULATE CHARGES
FOR ENHANCED 911 SERVICES

PURSUANT TO AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH NORTH CAROLINA STATUTES 62A-4, 62A-6, and 62A-7, THE CLAY COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS ORDAINS THAT:

SECTION I:

- A. Previous ordinance established charges to subscribers at \$2.00 per line for Enhanced 911 services. This level of charge was necessary to cover charges for equipment and installation thereof.
- B. All equipment for the system has been purchased, installed, and paid for.
- C. Funds on deposit in the Emergency Telephone System Fund are sufficient to maintain operation of the system for the current fiscal year.

SECTION II:

- A. Effective October 1, 1998, the monthly rate charged to subscribers for Enhanced 911 services is herewith reduced to \$1.00 (one dollar) per month.
- B. Collection of E911 fees by the Service Supplier, and deposit thereof by the County Finance Officer into the Emergency Telephone System Fund will continue as prescribed.

SECTION III:

- A. Previous ordinance prescribing fees in the amount of \$2.00 (two dollars) per month for subscribers is herewith repealed.
