

ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, various concerned individuals petitioned the Board of Commissioners for the County of Clay for the naming of the requested, Mason Road, in Brasstown Township, Clay County, North Carolina.

WHEREAS, naming said road would be in the best interest of the County and will facilitate designing and locating individuals and areas along said road.

WHEREAS, public notice was caused to be given by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Clay 10 days before the date set for hearing on naming the road; public notice was posted at the County Courthouse and in at least two public places in the township where the road is located, pursuant to N.C.G.S. §153A-240.

NOW, THEREFORE, the official name of the road which is the subject of the petition and SR #1179, shall be Mason Road.

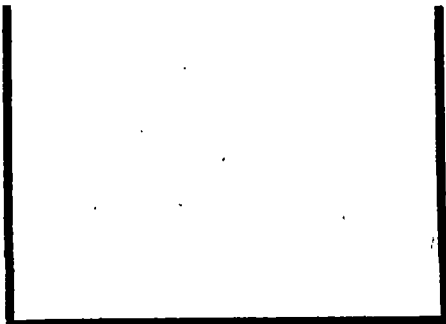
